US CARB UPDATES: PART 9 SELL-THROUGH DATES EXTENDED FOR CERTAIN COMPOSITE WOOD PRODUCTS

In 2007, the California Air Resource Board (CARB) approved an airborne toxic control measure (ATCM) regulation to reduce formaldehyde emissions from composite wood products including hardwood plywood (HWPW-VC and HWPW-CC), particleboard(PB), medium density fiberboard(MDF), thin medium density fiberboard (thickness ≤ 8mm), and also finished products made with composite wood products¹. Businesses required to comply with the Regulation are: manufacturers, distributors, importers, fabricators, and retailers of composite wood products and finished goods that contain these products. The Regulation establishes two tiers of formaldehyde emission standards. The Phase 1 formaldehyde emissions standards for HWPW-VC, PB, MDF, and thin MDF became effective on January 1, 2009; and for HWPW-CC on July 1, 2009. The Phase 2 emission standard for HWPW-VC will become effective on January 1, 2010.

In May 2009, CARB published Regulatory Advisory 09-02 to extend the sell-through dates by 4 months for distributors and retailers of composite wood panels manufactured before January 1, 2009².

After a number of surveys, CARB concluded that an extension of sell-through dates is necessary for

- Pre-Phase 1 composite wood products
- 2. Pre-Phase 1 Finished goods and
- 3. Phase 1 hardwood plywood with veneer core

On November 12, 2009, Regulatory Advisory 09-04 ³ was published to supersede Regulatory Advisories 09-02 and 09-01. This new Advisory announces a delay through December 31, 2010, in the enforcement of sell-through dates that apply to:

- 1. Distributors and retailers of pre-Phase 1 composite wood product panels
- 2. Distributors, importers, fabricators, and retailers of finished goods made with pre-Phase 1 composite wood products and
- 3. Distributors of Phase 1 compliant hardwood plywood with veneer core

- Pre-Phase 1 products are composite wood product panels manufactured before January 1, 2009, that do not comply with the Phase 1 emission standards specified in ARB's ATCM
- Pre-Phase 1 finished goods are finished goods made with pre-Phase 1 composite wood products
